

# Binoculars

The stock required for this project is for one pair of binoculars, if you are making more than one, simply increase the number of items you require by the number of people who will be participating.

## Items required for kit

- 2 cardboard rolls (like toilet rolls, or a food wrap role cut in half)
- 1 piece of coloured paper
- Sticky tape
- 1 piece of coloured ribbon (about 1 metre long)
- Single hole punch

## You will need:

- Pencils, Textas, glitter, stickers etc, as per your preference to decorate

## Instructions

- First of all place both the cardboard tubes together side by side and sticky tape together. The outcome here will be that you can hold them up and look through from one end to the other. Ensure sticky tape does not block your view.
- At one end using the hole punch put a hole in each side (this is what you will use to tie the ribbon on)
- Cut the coloured piece of paper to fit around the tubes (at an estimate if your coloured paper is A4 this is approximately ½ length ways)
- Decorate to your liking with your own supplies, (textas, stickers etc)
- Once decorated, using sticky tape, stick coloured paper around pair of cardboard rolls. Ensure coloured paper is also stuck to the paper rolls.
- Attach ribbon using the holes on the side of the cardboard rolls.
- You now own your very own pair of binoculars
