

Easter Bunny Ears

The stock required for this project is for one pair of bunny ears, if you are making more than one, simply increase the number of items you require by the number of people who will be participating.

Items required for kit

- 1 A4 piece of white card
- 1 A4 Pieces of pink card
- Cardboard to make headband (you can use two sheets of A4 card stock and cut and join to make strip)
- Cotton balls

You will need:

- Sticky Tape
- Pink glitter to decorate pink inserts
- Glue
- Scissors

Instructions

- Cut and make a cardboard headband, then measure the head band around the child's head and trim to fit (allow cross over at ends to join)
- Draw two small ears on the sheet of pink A4 card. If you are worried about not getting it right you can fold the card in half and draw one ear, then when you cut it out you will in fact have two matching ears.
- Then using these pink ears as a template, draw bigger ears on the white A4 card. Cut these out too.
- Choose to either, decorate your ears with cotton balls, or the pink inserts
- If you are decorating with cotton balls, glue to ears covering almost whole ear, remember you need to allow a little bit at the bottom of the ear to join to the band. Approximately 1.5 cms.
- If you are decorating with pink inserts, paint / glitter the inserts, then glue inserts to main ears
- Sticky tape / Glue ears to the inside of the head band.
- Join the head band at the back and allow to dry.
